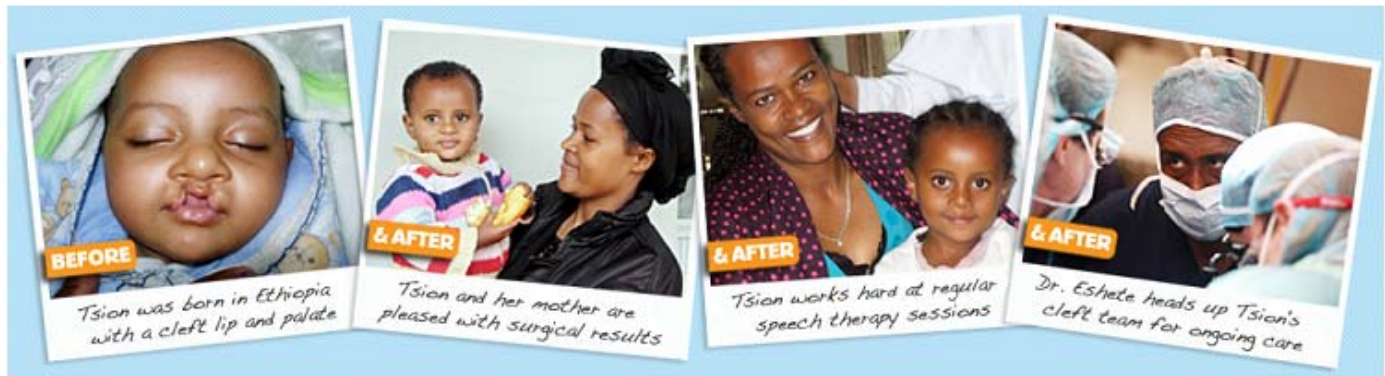

Transforming Faces, Transforming Lives

Transforming Faces Worldwide is a Toronto-based charity that promotes the availability of multidisciplinary cleft care for children and adults in developing countries. We establish and fund projects that improve access to long-term medical treatment for craniofacial disorders. We advocate strongly for comprehensive cleft care, meaning wherever possible our local cleft teams include: audiologists, dentists, nurse co-ordinators, orthodontists, social workers, speech therapists and surgeons.



OUR WORK IN INDIA

We partner with top Speech and Orthodontic specialists at Chennai's Sri Ramachandra University (SRU) to provide care to rural families in the Thiruvannamalai District.

The SRU team travels each month to rural communities to provide the following services:

- Identification of speech and hearing disorders
- Referrals to ENT specialists
- Speech therapy, using trained community-based rehabilitation (CBR) workers
- Dental and orthodontic work

Rehabilitation helps children to have normal speech and hearing, giving them a better chance of attending and performing well in school.

In 2011, 51 patients were seen and 21 were screened for orthodontic treatment.

The community-based rehabilitation workers began using mobile phones to follow up with patients to ensure that they are maintaining good oral hygiene practices.
